
Screw Collar Canopy Fixtures

skill level | basic electrician

installation instructions




- 1. Remove crossbar from assembly and attach crossbar to electrical box.
- 2. Loosen collar and slide canopy and collar down rod or chain.
- 3. Feed wires through center hole of crossbar.



- 4. Screw threaded pipe loosely into crossbar.
- 5. Check fit of canopy by placing it snug against ceiling. Adjust depth of assembly so that collar fitting extends beyond bottom of canopy by 1/4".
- 6. Tighten jamb nut upward against crossbar to lock assembly in position.
- 7. Make wiring connections in accordance with local electrical codes. See "Important Information" on reverse side.
- 8. Slide canopy up against ceiling and secure with collar.






Assembly Instructions

- 1. Lay a towel or thin blanket on the floor or large table to prevent scratches. Smooth out any wrinkles.
- 2. Arrange the **glass panels** in a circle on the towel or blanket (see Figure A). Small gaps where the panels meet are okay and characteristic of handmade glass. Your panels may have a different decorative pattern but the assembly procedure is the same.








5. With a partner, grasp the hang brackets and lift up the shade assembly an inch or two to ensure there are no loose fastners.



The next step is to insert suspension rods per **Suspended Rod Ball End Installation Instructions.**







installation instructions

Three People are recommended to complete this installation.

- 1. Complete center fixture installation according to "Screw Collar Canopy Fixtures Installation Instructions" and assemble the shade per "Assembly Instruction Three Piece Round Glass Shade".
- 2. In preparation, locate the (3) **rods** with one **ball end** pre-attached. To hang them from the **canopy plate**, you will need to temporarily un-screw the **collar** holding the canopy, and lower the canopy enough to pass the ball between ceiling and plate.
- 3. Slide the rod through one of the **slots** to the **hole**. The ball end should seat in the large hole of the canopy plate. (see Fig. A) Repeat for remaining (2) rods.
- 4. Re-tighten the collar, pushing the canopy back to the ceiling.




- 5. Locate the remaining (3) ball ends (not attached).
- 6. It is now time to lift and hang the shade assembly. With (2) people lift the **shade assembly** under, then up and around the fixture sockets.
- 7. The third person will position shade and insert a **rod** end through a **hang bracket** of the **shade assembly** and screw on the second **ball-end** (see Fig. B). Repeat for all (3) rods at each hang bracket. Screw ball-ends on until tight. There should be no exposed **threads**.
- 8. Ensure the ball-ends are seated in the hang brackets and the slotted holes of the canopy as you <u>slowly and gently</u> allow the shade assembly to hang. You can expect the shade panels to settle slightly, as it hangs.
